Bargaining Update

November 17, 2004

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

At 0300, Wednesday November 17, 2004 the Running Trades Bargaining Committee reached a tentative settlement with CN Rail which allows the railway to integrate and make changes to the operations on the BC Rail property.

Some highlights of the agreement include;

- 1) Maintain our current Collective Agreement (including banking time, rest provisions, accommodations, eating, boot allowances etc) for an extra year (December 31, 2006) with the current Bonus Plan in effect for 2004, a 3% wage increase for 2006 as well as the opportunity to re-negotiate our own collective agreement at its expiration.
- 2) Enhanced severance and/or relocation opportunities, locked in at a specific number and transferable to other locations.

The bargaining committee is scheduling membership meetings for the week starting November 22 thru the 26th to explain the agreement and to obtain a vote. (Schedule Attached)

UTU Canadian Vice President Bob Sharpe and CAW National Transportation Director Gary Fane were instrumental in getting this agreement and the committee thanks them for their hard work and experience in this effort.
